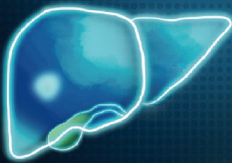

Registration cancellations notified with a written notice received by Event Secretariat on or before **30th September 2025 at 23:59 (GMT +8)**, will be subjected to a **25% administration fee**. After this date, no refund can be made for cancellation.
